THE COURSE

Designed by The CAM Academy Trust and facilitated by experienced school leaders and teachers, the OTL programme arms experienced teachers with high-level skills and strategies. With opportunities to explore pedagogical approaches, it also provides delegates with the ability to coach colleagues in their own school to help raise performance levels.

The programme consists of 4 day-long sessions, and each day includes an observation/tour in the host school:

Day 1: Inspire and engage and impact on learning

Day 2: Collaboration

Day 3: Motivation and Independence
